Dear Friends,

Hungry Hearts Foundation is thrilled to report another incredible year of record-breaking growth in 2018.

We **more than doubled our year over year (YOY) revenue**, ending fiscal 2018 with a total of nearly \$70,000! This has been achieved through a mixture of grants, food donations, corporate matches, and for a large part the tremendous monetary support we continue to receive from the community.

Our services grew significantly in 2018 as well. We provided over \$22,000 just for food and necessities as direct assistance to our kids. In 2017, we averaged around 160 children in our program. We ended 2018 with over 220 children supported, a **37.5% YOY** increase!

With the increase in total number of children supported, more food needed to be procured and stored, and we quickly outgrew our current storage capacity. This rapid growth necessitated an investment in a new, larger, storage space, which the Foundation had to start renting. This brought on additional operational costs that were not present in 2017, but will be present going forward. The Foundation also acquired industrial refrigeration equipment which will allow us to store and distribute fresh or frozen foods!

Last year we also helped a newly-formed non-profit organization by the name of Operation Sky Valley get up and running during their inaugural year. They provide similar services to ours, in the Sky Valley region in our neighboring cities along Highway 2, and we are thrilled to have been able to assist!

Looking ahead to 2019, we are planning exciting new fundraisers and having our community come together to have fun while raising money and food for our foundation. We are also looking into providing additional services in the schools we support.

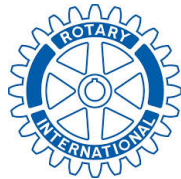
The amazing support from the community is what continues to drive our tremendous growth and success. We are thrilled by the positive momentum and results we see, and we aim to keep doing what we're doing!
