Dear Friends,

As we close out the decade, and our fifth year of existence, Hungry Hearts Foundation is excited to report another solid year in 2019!

We ended fiscal 2019 with a total of \$66,000 in revenue (which was 5% higher than we budgeted) and \$52,000 in expenses! This has been achieved through a mixture of grants, food donations, corporate matches, and for a large part the tremendous monetary support we continue to receive from the community. At this point in time, our organization is well-funded at the current capacity we have, with a healthy reserve should we experience a downturn in the near future.

During the year, our services yet again experienced significant growth, as we provided over \$29,000 worth of food distributions, as direct assistance to our kids. In 2018, we averaged around 220 children in our program. We ended 2019 with nearly 226 children supported!

The continued growth has been managed expertly by the Board of Directors. The investment in a new, larger, storage space, which the Foundation had to start renting in 2018, as well as the industrial-size equipment in our storage space, has proven very effective, efficient, and useful.

Looking ahead to 2020 and the coming decade, we are planning more exciting new fundraisers and having our community come together to have fun while raising money and food for our foundation. We are always continuing to look into providing additional services at the schools we support.

On behalf of the organization and the Board, I would like to extend a heartfelt “thank you” to our wonderful volunteers, sponsors, and the community. Your trust and faith in us over the last five years has been incredibly delightful to feel. It’s the fuel that keeps us going, and we can’t wait to see what the new decade will bring!
